

The BCANDS Logo, seen below in three different formats, or “BCANDS Feather” was created by Mr. Allan Thickfoot who is a self-taught, Cree artist, who has quadriplegia, and is from the Fisher Creek First Nation, located on the shores of Lake Winnipeg (Koostatak), Manitoba. Mr. Thickfoot created the BCANDS Feather in 1992 while living in British Columbia, at the request of the BCANDS founders.



The eagle's head depicted inside the BCANDS feather represents the strength of all persons with disabilities, while the red drop contained within the peak of the feather specifically represents Indigenous people with disabilities.
